Capacity building

- Help create Research Center for Regulation and Competition (RCRC) in 1999
- Need for education:
 - Take graduate students abroad
 - Wuhan Ph.D. Program
- Need for research
 - Joint work (Laffont as a "godfather of researchers")
- Need for training and consulting
 - Training program for regulatory agencies with the help of the World Bank Institute

The impact in telecoms

- Impacts of his work
 - Big success of his book Competition in Telecommunications
- Provide intellectual support to the regulator on major regulatory reforms and policies
 - Restructuring of China's telecom sector
 - Interconnection policy (more later)

The impact on interconnections

- *ad hoc* interconnection pricing $a_i = \gamma_i p_i$
 - (Estache-Laffont-Zhang, 2001)
 - Tariff-based interconnection pricing
 - Major insights of Laffont-Rey-Tirole (1998) still hold
 - Retail prices are lower
 - prices wars prevail in China's telecom markets
- Help the telecom regulator design cost-based interconnection pricing in 2003-2004

The impact on poverty related topics

- Universal service obligations and network investment (Estache-Laffont-Zhang, 2001)
- Rural users are favored by uniform pricing
- Network is smaller than discriminatory pricing or without USOs, or many remained unconnected
- Do not distort incentives for investment in LDCs

The institutional impact

- Big success of the RCRC Center with his support and promotion
- Help establish regulatory agency of electricity in 2002
- Lasting impact on how policy issues are being thought through:
 - Ongoing project on design of price cap regulation for telecom regulator with the help of the World Bank (GICT)
